- Rudder can be raised and lowered easily from the cockpit for rudderless exercises.
- Small skeg and raked rudder help beginners to handle the boat with ease.
- Capsize recovery is easy for even the lightest sailors – comes up dry every time.
- The [RS Tera](#) has a strong tow line fitted as standard.
